## Steps in Preparing a NIH Proposal

- 1. Choosing a topic
  - --talking with lots of people to be sure of topic
- 2. Making sure there is a sound methodology that can be applied to topic
- 3. Review literature to:
  - a. identify all research done on topic
  - b. develop theories (ideally competing theories) focused on topic
- 4. Write introduction and lit review
- 5. Identify all variables that need to be measured (found in theories to be tested) and the statistical procedures to be used
- 6. Determine how to obtain the variables to be measured (e.g., mix methods)
- 7. Write methods section
- 8. Write all other sections required by funder
